

Phenylephrine 10mg/mL (1mL vial)

Visually Impaired

If you are visually impaired and need help reading your label we can help. At your request, a prescription reader is available to patients in need. What is this medication?

Phenylephrine is a vasoconstrictor commonly used in compounded formulations for its ability to constrict blood vessels. It may be prescribed for urological, ophthalmic, or surgical purposes depending on your provider's instructions.

What are the ingredients?

Phenylephrine HCl 10mg/mL.

What should I tell my healthcare provider before I take this medication?

Tell your provider if you:

- Have heart disease, high blood pressure, or circulation problems
- Are pregnant or breastfeeding
- Take other prescription, over-the-counter, or herbal products

How should I use this medication?

- Use exactly as directed by your healthcare provider.
- This medication is typically administered via injection; follow proper sterile technique.
- Do not reuse syringes or needles.

What if I miss a dose?

This medication is often administered on an as-needed basis. If you are on a regular dosing schedule and miss a dose, follow your provider's instructions or call your pharmacist.

What may interact with this medication?

- MAO inhibitors
- Blood pressure medications
- Stimulants or decongestants

Always check with your provider before starting or stopping any medication, including non-prescription products.

What side effect:

Common side effects may include:

- Headache
- Dizziness
- Increased blood pressure or heart rate

Seek medical attention for:

- Chest pain
- Irregular heartbeat
- Severe headache

This list may not describe all possible side effects. Call your doctor for medical advice about side effects and any unusual problems while taking this medication. If you experience a serious side effect, you or your doctor may send a report to the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) MedWatch Adverse Event Reporting program, online (www.fda.gov/Safety/MedWatch) or by phone (1-800-332-1088)

What should I watch while using this medication?

- Monitor blood pressure and heart rate if instructed
- Watch for signs of allergic reaction or overdose
- Do not exceed prescribed dose

Where should I keep my medication?

- Store in original vial at room temperature or as directed on the label
- Protect from moisture
- Keep out of reach of children

Disposal: Do not flush or pour unused medication down the drain. The best option is to use a DEA-authorized drug take-back location, which you can find at rxdrugdropbox.org. If that's not available, mix the medication (still in its vial or drawn into a syringe) with an undesirable substance like used coffee grounds or cat litter, seal it in a plastic bag, and discard it in the household trash—after removing any personal information from the label. Used syringes must be placed in an FDA-cleared sharps container and taken to an appropriate sharps disposal site. If you're unsure, contact your pharmacist at 727-498-1228 for guidance.
